CATEGORY	ORDER NO.	OCCASIONS WHEN WORN
<b>CEREMONIAL DRESS</b>	C1	A formal order of dress, worn on occasion including: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. formal ceremonies or parades;</li> <li>b. guards of honour; and</li> <li>c. church services or parades.</li> </ul>
<b>TRADITIONAL HIGHLAND DRESS</b>	C1	To be promulgated.
<b>MESS DRESS</b>	C1H	A formal or routine order of dress for Highland units and pipe bands.
<b>SERVICE DRESS</b>	C2	Optional formal order of dress worn on the following occasions: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. mess or formal dinners; and</li> <li>b. other occasions as ordered.</li> </ul>
<b>SERVICE DRESS</b>	C3	Routine daily duty.

	C3B	At the discretion of corps / squadron CO
	C3C	At the discretion of corps / squadron CO
	C3D	At the discretion of corps / squadron CO
	C3E	Travel dress. Service dress at the discretion of corps / squadron CO
